## **Application Methods:**

## Spinach

Ground: Apply at the rate of 3 to 6 pints per acre to spinach at the 4-true leaf stage or larger in 10 to 20 gallons of water on a broadcast basis.

Band application: See label for dosage

Air: Apply at the rate of 3 to 6 pints per acre to spinach at the 4-true leaf stage or larger using 5 to 20 gallons of spray per acre.

Reduced Rates: Can be applied as a split application for weed control. The first application of only 2 1/2 to 3 pints per acre can be applied at the 2 to 4-leaf stage of spinach (instead of the 4 to 6 true-leaf stage) followed by a sequential application of only 3 pints, 4 to 6 days later. Use maximum of 6 pints per acre per year total with this method

## Red (Garden) Beets

Ground: Multiple applications may be applied by ground to red (garden) beets to control early germinating weeds. See Label for Broadcast and Band Application rates. The first application must be applied when the red (garden) beets have reached the 2-leaf stage. Any weeds which are not completely controlled by the first treatment will usually be checked or controlled by repeat applications.
